Newsletter - November 2011

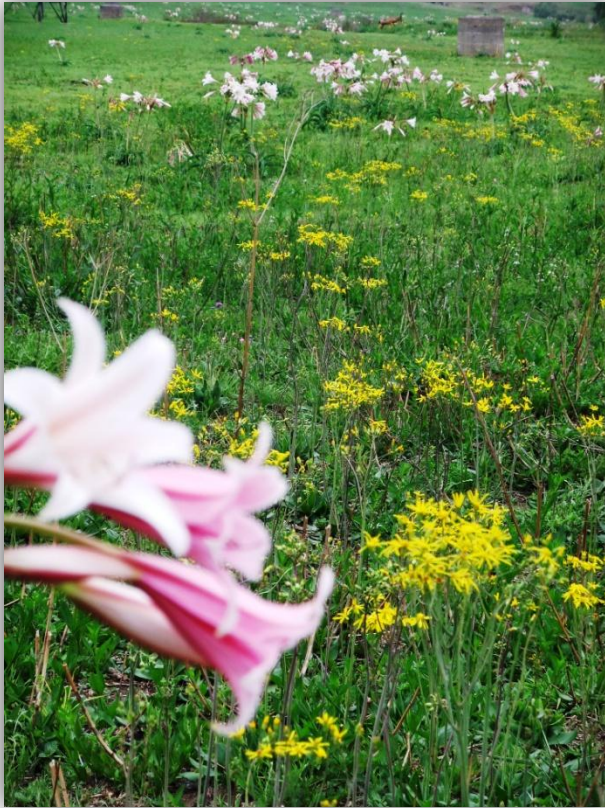
